About Simhastha Kumbh Mela

The **Nashik–Trimbakeshwar Simhastha Kumbh Mela** is one of the world's largest and holiest Hindu pilgrimages, celebrated once every 12 years in **Nashik** and **Trimbakeshwar**, Maharashtra. Millions of devotees, saints, and pilgrims gather on the banks of the sacred **Godavari River** to participate in holy rituals and take a sacred bath during the auspicious **Amrit Snan** dates.

The festival officially begins with the **Dhwajaroohan (Flag Hoisting)** ceremony and concludes with the **Flag Lowering Ceremony**, spanning from **31 October 2026** to **24 July 2028**.
